The rules written here should facilitate the smooth progress of the competition and help players and administrators resolve conflicts. The most important principle is that teams and players try, in accordance with their abilities, to play and finish their matches no matter what happens.

About rulebook

The rules of this league are subject to change until the very beginning, and possibly during the league depending on the circumstances. For all possible changes, participants of the Balkan PUBG League will be notified on the official website or Discord of the league.

Violations of these rules by an individual or team may result in disqualification from the league.

1. League administrators

You can contact the league administrators with any questions that are not covered by this rulebook. Unnecessary spamming and/or insulting the administrator can result in the disqualification of the entire league team.

2. Signups

2.1. Age and location

All registered players must be at least 16 years old. There may be age exceptions, but this will be decided by the administrators.

Registered Balkan players must come from one of the following countries:

- Croatia
- Serbia
- Slovenia
- Bosnia and Herzegovina
- Montenegro
- Albania
- Macedonia
- Kosovo
- Bulgaria
- Romania
- Greece

Each team has the right to register one player from the EU Region, regardless of whether the player is in the main lineup (main roster) or in substitutions (subs). The exceptions are players from the CIS region, for which the administrators will decide individually. If you

have a player from the CIS region, it needs to be approved by the administrator in advance. Players from the NA, SA, MEA, APAC and OCE regions are not allowed to play BPL.

An EU Region player cannot be a team captain!

BPL reserves the right to request a valid document of an individual to confirm the year and place of birth. There are two general categories of evidence: documents issued by the state and private documents. Minors can also have a parent or guardian who proves residence on their behalf by first providing documents and evidence of the parent/guardian-child relationship (e.g. birth certificate), and submit documents belonging to the parent/guardian, as stated above.

2.2. Player registration and accounts

You are only allowed to play through your own Steam account.

Account sharing is strictly forbidden and will be punished by banning the entire team for a period of one season (not including the current season)!

Team names and logos must not be offensive, and usage of national or religious characteristics is forbidden.

Only one team of the same organization/owner may be registered during one season.

Each team must have a unique name and logo, academy teams are not allowed to participate if the main team is also on the list of participants.

Player names must not contain offensive language.

2.3. Qualifier Signups

Each team registers 4 players and 2 substitutions. After the team has confirmed a place in the top 16, all players from the team will receive the appropriate roles on our Discord server. Only players with the role of their team can see crucial messages for playing matches and information for teams.

Applications for BPL Season 9 are open from 09.10.2021 until 17.10.2021 23:59, while applications for the tenth season of BPL will be open at the end of the current season.

Registration for the league is free.

The number of teams that will play in the league is 16.

You can submit your application through our web site.

3. Playing

The league will be played through PUBG's custom servers, created by the BPL organization according to the rules below (item 7). All news or information about the change of rules will be available on the official website of the league!

3.1. League duration

Each league season will last approximately a month.

The 9th BPL season will take place on the following dates:

- Tuesday, 09.11. - 19:30
- Wednesday, 10.11. - 19:30
- Tuesday, 16.11. - 19:30
- Wednesday, 17.11. - 19:30
- Tuesday, 30.11. - 19:30
- Wednesday, 01.12. - 19:30

The season will consist of 32 matches.

3.2. Matches

Od maksimalno 32 meča koja će se igrati u toku jedne sezone, igraju se:

16x Miramar
16x Erangel

Rezultati odigranih matcheva ažurirati će se putem naše web stranice lige, nakon što match završi. Tablica sa rezultatima se ažurira automatski nakon završetka meča, što može potrajati i do 10 minuta.

3.3. Rules between seasons

Teams that finished the previous season in the top 8 teams are automatically placed in the next BPL season. Teams that finish between ninth and fourteenth place at the end of the season are placed directly in the qualifying finals for next season. The last two teams have to play qualifiers from the beginning.

In order for the team to keep the slot from the previous season, at least two players from the main roster must stay. The team captain is entitled to the slot of his team, in case the team has retained 50% of the main roster. In the case of a legally valid organization, the organization is entitled to a slot regardless of the captain's decision, as long as it can retain 50% of the main lineup.

The main roster includes the first four registered players, without substitutes.

3.4. Rules during the season

Teaming

Teaming means consciously helping another team or teams for your own benefit or for the benefit of another team/teams.

Teams that are proven to have participated in the "teaming" will be given a penalty. The penalty for the first violation of this rule is the deduction of 80 points.

In the event of a second violation of this rule, disqualification from the league will follow. Penalties are permanent and it is impossible for them to expire.

No-show

Teams are required to play at every BPL match. In case a team appears with 3 players it will be assigned a warning percentage. Warning status increases by 20% for each match played. When a team gains 100% warning status all players will be banned from competing in the next BPL season. Warning percentages are not carried over to next season.

3.5. Lineup

The team consists of 4 players, one of whom is the captain, three players are members of the main roster, and two possible substitutes (subs).

Each team has the right to register one player from the EU Region, regardless of whether the player is in the main roster or in the substitutes.

An EU Region player cannot be a team captain!

Substitutions can be changed in the middle of the season (after 15 matches played, and before the 16th match, i.e. between the third and fourth day of play). In the same period, it is possible to move a player from the main lineup to the sub (substitution) and vice versa, if the player from the sub position (substitution) played at least 1 match of the first part of the season. A team may change a maximum of 2 players from sub positions (substitutions) in the half-season.

If a player from the main roster decides to leave the team after a roster lock, they lose the right to play for other teams in the current season.

If a player has played at least 1 match for one team (including qualifiers), he is not eligible to play for other teams during the current season.

If three or more players from the main roster decide to leave the team after the roster lock, the team (including the players) automatically loses the right to play the current and next BPL season!

If one of the teams is disqualified during the season, the place will go to the ninth-placed team in the previous qualifiers. If the ninth-placed team is not ready to play the entire season, the administrators reserve the right to decide on the team that will receive a place in the current season. The team that is subsequently invited to compete in the current season will take over the points won by the disqualified team.

A team cannot start a match with less than three players. In the case of playing with three players, the rules from point [3.4 No-show](#) apply.

3.6. Technical problems

Teams are responsible for their technical issues (hardware/software/internet). Matches will not be postponed due to technical problems of players and matches will be played regardless of player problems.

Due to technical problems on our side,, it is possible to postpone matches.

4. Prize pool

1. Place - 1500€
2. Place - 750€
3. Place - 500€
4. Place - 250€

The prize pool for the 9th season is € 3,000!

Prior to the payment of prizes, all taxes, contributions, fees and other administrative costs prescribed by the laws of the Republic of Serbia will be calculated. Prizes are expressed in gross amounts.

The deadline for the payment of prizes is 60 days from the delivery of the data required for payment to the organizers by the team captain.

5. Varanje i suspenzije

If a team has a player who is currently suspended/banned, the entire team will be disqualified for two seasons.

If you register a player who has used disallowed software in their history or is currently on the ban list, you automatically lose the right to play BPL.

5.1. Cheating

Any kind of use of cheating software will result in permanent disqualification of the team and all players. Usage of following tools/software/bugs is strictly forbidden:

- ESP
- Radar hacks
- Wallhacks
- Speedhacks
- Aimhacks
- Teleport hacks
- Usage of any bugs
- Editing crucial game files in order to remove foliage, building etc..
- Macro and other scripts
- Any tools that give you an advantage over other players

5.2. RWB (Return While Banned)

If a player, regardless of the current ban, decides to play in a league or qualifier under a different name and/or team, the ban will extend the current ban for 2 seasons. All players who have played with the person who committed the above offense will be prevented from playing the current and next season of the BPL.

5.3. Reporting to the administrator

The player must have a valid reason to submit a report to the administrator. Before the user files a report, the user must make sure that the evidence presented is credible evidence that the accused person or team has violated the rules. Accusations based on rage should be avoided at all costs. If a user submits multiple false reports, he risks being temporarily disabled from submitting more reports.

6. Streaming

If there is an official stream, streaming your POV is strictly forbidden. If there are no official streams, you are allowed to stream your POV.

7. In-game Rules

7.1. Match Rules

The rules under point 7 from the above link (In-game settings) will be applied in the BPL.

Points are awarded depending on the position and number of kills.

7.2. Server Restart

Servers will only be restarted if more than 10% of players fail to connect, or if the server settings are not appropriate.

Servers will not be restarted due to player irresponsibility.
